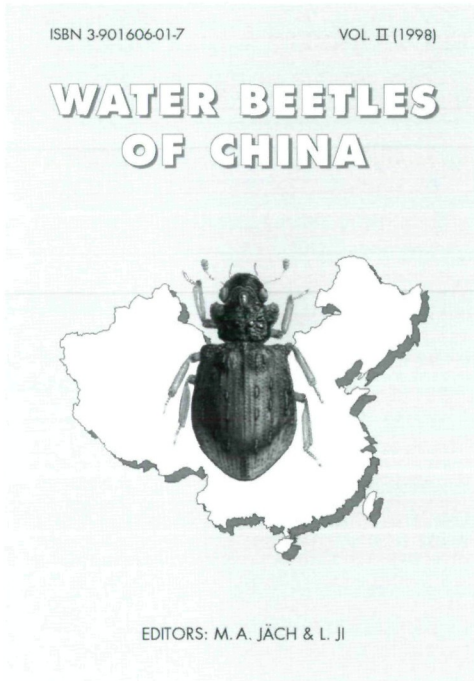


## WATER BEETLES OF CHINA



The "China Water Beetle Survey" is a joint project of the Natural History Museum, Vienna (Section of Coleopterology) and the Chinese Academy of Sciences (Inst. of Applied Ecology, Shenyang) aiming at thoroughly surveying the biodiversity of the aquatic and riparian beetles of China. Its scientific results are published in the "**Water Beetles of China**".

Two comprehensive volumes of the "**Water Beetles of China**" were published so far. These two volumes contain 46 articles (including numerous thorough taxonomic revisions) compiled by 33 authors from 15 countries. Five new genera and about 100 new species and subspecies are described therein. General information, keys, distributional data and comprehensive bibliographies are provided. Both books are richly illustrated and contain numerous colour plates.
