The Austrian collections are extremely rich of old and rare specimens. These four institutions together hold probably more than 400.000 types. The databasing was started few years ago and at the moment for c. 63.000 specimens the data are available, of these c. 4.700 types, most of them with a scanned picture.

The database has standardised fields for taxa (genera / epithets / authors), collectors, countries and provinces. It is possible to search for each of these fields or combining them, or for continents. For geo-referenced specimens it is possible to get a map or satellit photo of the area. It is also possible to create a map for a selected list of specimens.

The data are entered directly online and are stored for each instution separately.

**Any instiution which wants to join this initiative, is welcome.**

For testing the database you may use *Briza media* with as reasonable number of geo-referenced specimens and the Bromeliaceae or Africa with many scanned types.
