

Short botanical notes

The herbaria in Vienna are very rich in old and valuable collections and hold together probably more than 300.000 type specimens. Many visitors inform the curators of new findings and results, that probably will never be published being not enough for a separate publication. However, these data should be published for not being lost. Therefore the curators of W and WU decided to edit a series of short notes in this and following volumes of the Annalen des Naturhistorischen Museums, which are open for any taxonomical or floristic reports. The herbarium acronyms follow the Index Herbariorum (<http://sweetgum.nybg.org/ih/>), nomenclatoric authors are abbreviated according to the "International Plant Names Index" (<http://www.ipni.org/> – search option "authors").

Lectotype of *Utricularia endresii* RCHB.f. (Lentibulariaceae)

TAYLOR (1989) indicated as types "Costa Rica, Endres s.n., cult. Veitch (W holo, K iso)" However, these specimens have not been the only ones, on which the original description was based.

REICHENBACH (1874) mentions the collection of Endres as "The pretty plant was collected by Señor Endres " and later "I saw the plant lately in full profusion of flower-buds at the Royal Exotic Nursery of Messrs. Veitch" (obviously living!). The original specimen collected by Endres exists in W. During his visit of the Nursery of Veitch Reichenbach had collected additional specimens before the publication of the new species - on the sheet in Vienna is the date "Sept. 1874" Thus all these collections are syntypes of which a lectotype has to be selected. For continuity the specimen mentioned as "holotype" by TAYLOR (1989) is chosen.

Utricularia endresii RCHB.f., Gard. Chron. 1874/2: 582 (November 1874).

Lectotype (hic designatus): [cult.] Veitch, Sept. 1874, s. coll. [cf. Reichenbach] [W 1889-286465, isotype K];

Other syntype: Costa Rica, s.dat., Endres [W 1889-152214].
